Type of Request: Revision of a currently approved collection.

Description of the need for the information and proposed use: The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) seeks to collection information that will be used to monitor and manage the cooperative agreements awarded under the Community Compass Technical Assistance and Capacity Building program. This collection is being revised to remove all information collected during the application process for the Community Compass Technical Assistance and Capacity Building program. Pre-award information collection for this program will now be covered by HUD's Generic Solution for Solicitation for Competitive Discretionary Funding Opportunity Announcements (2501-0044).

Respondents: Awardees under HUD's Community Compass Technical Assistance and Capacity Building program.
