### Town Hall Meetings to Provide Input on Cyber Incident Reporting for Critical Infrastructure Act (CIRCA) Rulemaking

**AGENCY:** Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency, Department of Homeland Security.

**ACTION:** Notification of revised town hall meetings schedule.

**SUMMARY:** This notice announces a revised town hall meeting schedule to allow external stakeholders a limited additional opportunity to provide input on refining the scope and burden of the CIRCA Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (NPRM) issued in the *Federal Register* on April 4, 2024. The proposed CIRCA rulemaking seeks to implement the Cyber Incident Reporting for Critical Infrastructure Act of 2022, as amended, by implementing covered cyber incident and ransom payment reporting requirements for covered entities.

All town hall meetings are tentatively scheduled to take place from 11:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Eastern Time. CISA reserves the right to revise the schedule, reschedule, or cancel any of these town hall meetings for any reason, including for severe weather, a health emergency, a lack of registered attendees, or an incident that impacts CISA’s ability to safely conduct these meetings at the proposed date, time, or location.
