The Scallop Committee will meet to develop recommendations for Scallop Research Set-Aside priorities for 2027/2028 and 2028/2029. They also plan to discuss Scallop Framework 42: Receive an update on the timeline and provide input on the

development of expected measures. This action will be initiated at the June 2026 Council meeting. Also on the agenda is Scallop Long-Term Strategic Plan: Develop recommendations for sequencing Scallop Strategic Plan work items for 2027-2029. Other business will be discussed, if necessary.
