[Order No. 2183]

Approval of Subzone Status; ECI Gulf Coast Parts and Service, Inc.; New Iberia, Louisiana

Pursuant to its authority under the Foreign-Trade Zones Act of June 18, 1934, as amended (19 U.S.C. 81a-81u), the Foreign-Trade Zones Board (the Board) adopts the following Order:

WHEREAS, the Foreign-Trade Zones (FTZ) Act provides for "...the establishment... of foreign-trade zones in ports of entry of the United States, to expedite and encourage foreign commerce, and for other purposes," and authorizes the Foreign-Trade Zones Board to grant to qualified corporations the privilege of establishing foreign-trade zones in or adjacent to U.S. Customs and Border Protection ports of entry;

WHEREAS, the Board's regulations (15 CFR part 400) provide for the establishment of subzones for specific uses;

WHEREAS, the Port of South Louisiana, grantee of Foreign-Trade Zone 124, has made application to the Board for the establishment of a subzone at the facility of ECI Gulf Coast Parts and Service, Inc., located in New Iberia, Louisiana (FTZ Docket B-11-2026, docketed January 28, 2026);

WHEREAS, notice inviting public comment has been given in the *Federal Register* (91 FR 4059, January 30, 2026) and the application has been processed pursuant to the FTZ Act and the Board's regulations; and,

WHEREAS, the Board adopts the findings and recommendations of the examiners' memorandum, and finds that the requirements of the FTZ Act and the Board's regulations are satisfied;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board hereby approves subzone status at the facility of ECI Gulf Coast Parts and Service, Inc., located in New Iberia, Louisiana (Subzone 124X), as described in the application and *Federal Register* notice, subject to the FTZ Act and the Board's regulations, including section 400.13.
